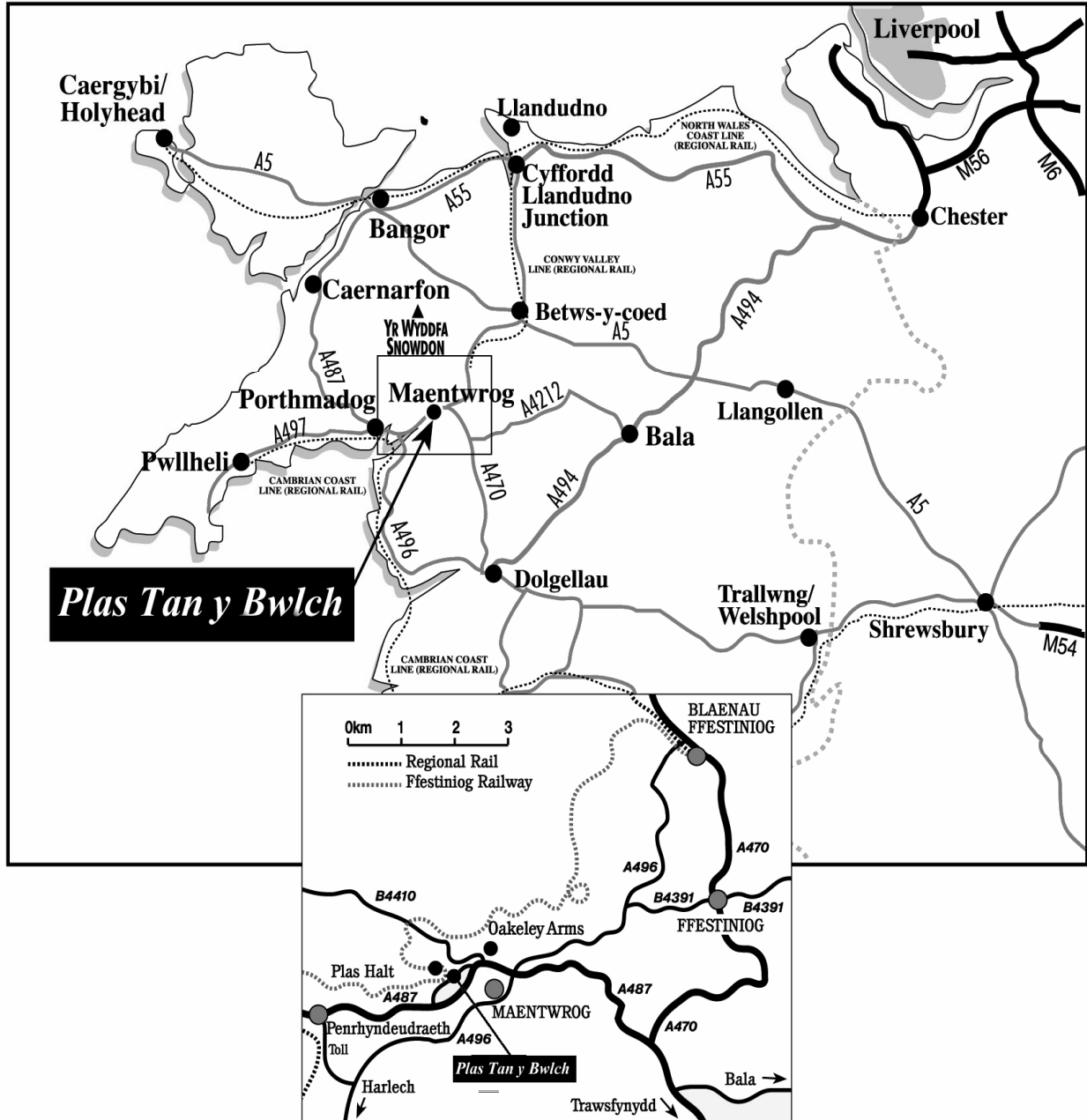

Trafnidiaeth Gyhoeddus

'Rydym yn awyddus iawn i hyrwyddo defnyddio trafnidiaeth gyhoeddus er mwyn ceisio lleihau llygredd, ac i wneud ein rhan i ysgafnhau pwysau traffig ym Mharc Cenedlaethol Eryri. Os y byddwch yn teithio ar drafnidiaeth cyhoeddus i'r Plas byddwch yn derbyn tocyn anrheg o £5.

Teithio ar y Trên:

Y ffordd orau i gyrraedd y Plas ar drafnidiaeth gyhoeddus yw teithio ar y trê'n i Gyffordd Llandudno ac yna ar Reilffordd Dyffryn Conwy i Flaenau Ffestiniog. O'r Blaenau mae gennych dri dewis - naill ai cymryd Trê'n Bach Ffestiniog i orsaf Plas Halt a thaith 10 munud o gerdded drwy'r goedlan i lawr i Blas Tan y Bwlch, byddai hyn yn gweddu i rai sy'n hoff o deithio'n ysgafn gyda sach ar y cefn. Opsiwn arall fyddai dal y bws o'r Blaenau i'r Oakeley Arms ac yna 5 munud o waith cerdded i fyny'r dreif ddwyreiniol i'r Plas. Fel arall gallwch logi tacsï (5 milltir o'r Blaenau i'r Plas).

Gallwch hefyd deithio ar y trê'n o orsaf Amwythig ar Reilffordd y Cambrian i bentref Minffordd ac yna ar Drê'n Bach Ffestiniog i Blas Halt neu ddisgyn oddi ar y trê'n ym mhentref Penrhyndeudraeth a dal y bws i'r Oakeley Arms, sydd yn daith o 4 milltir.

Os nad oes 'run o'r opsiynau hyn ar gael a bod digon o staff ar ddyletswydd gallwn ddod i'ch cyfarfod i orsaf Blaenau Ffestiniog neu Penrhyndeudraeth ym mws mini y Ganolfan.

Teithio ar y Bws:

I rai'n teithio o Dde Cymru, mae Gwasanaeth Bws 701 y Traws-Cambria yn aros ger yr Oakeley Arms. Mae cwmni bysus y National Express yn rhedeg dau wasanaeth i Borthmadog; bws rhif 390 i Fanceinion a Lerpwl a rhif 545 o Birmingham a Llundain.

Teithio mewn Car:

Mae Plas Tan y Bwlch tua milltir i'r gorllewin o Faentwrog, oddi ar y A487 i Borthmadog. Mae'r brif fynydfa yn cychwyn gyferbyn â Gwesty'r Oakeley Arms. (Gweler y map).

Public Transport

We are keen to promote the use of public transport in an effort to reduce pollution, and to play our part in reducing traffic congestion in the Snowdonia National Park. If you travel to the Plas for one of our courses by public transport you will receive a £5 gift voucher.

Travelling by Train:

The main access to Plas by public transport would be to travel by train to Llandudno Junction and then take the Conwy Valley Line to Blaenau Ffestiniog. From Blaenau Ffestiniog you have three options - either take the Narrow Gauge Ffestiniog Railway to Plas Halt and then take a 10 minute woodland walk downhill to Plas Tan y Bwlch; this would be suitable for those who travel light and use a rucksack. Another option would be to take the Bus Service from Blaenau Ffestiniog to the Oakeley Arms, from where it is only a 5 minute walk up the east drive to Plas, or you could take a taxi (5 miles from Blaenau to the Plas).

You can also travel by train from Shrewsbury Station on the Cambrian Line to the village of Minffordd and then take the Ffestiniog Narrow Gauge Railway to Plas Halt or come off the Cambrian Line at the village of Penrhyndeudraeth and take the bus to the Oakeley Arms which is only a 4 mile bus ride.

If none of these options are available and we have staff on duty we could meet you at the Blaenau Ffestiniog or Penrhyndeudraeth railway station in the Centre's minibus.

Travelling by Coach:

For those travelling from South Wales, the Traws-Cambria 701 stops at the Oakeley Arms. National Express operate two services to Porthmadog. Bus number 390 from Manchester and Liverpool, and number 545 from Birmingham and London.

Travelling in a Car:

Plas Tan y Bwlch is situated one mile west of Maentwrog, just off the A487 road to Porthmadog. The main drive starts opposite the Oakeley Arms Hotel. (See map).
